The Fund For Veterans' Assistance provides financial assistance to eligible San Patricio County Veterans, their dependents, and surviving spouses. Financial assistance may include rent, mortgage, utilities (water, gas, electric), food, transportation ride, vehicle payments and repairs, and assistive technology.

TO QUALIFY:

Veteran must have received an Honorable, General Under Honorable Conditions, or Uncharacterized discharge. Applicant must meet specific income requirements and demonstrate financial need.

DD214 (Member 4 copy)
Valid State Issued ID/DL, or Military ID

Spouse:

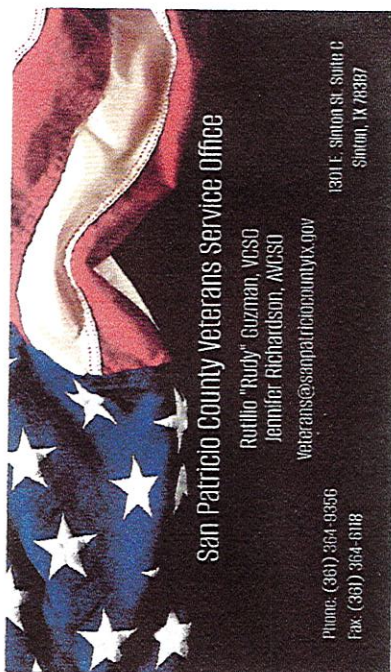
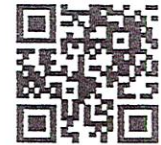
