Republic Services will only service brush and bulky items and only piles up to 12-yards.

Construction debris & bagged waste will not be picked up - it will be the resident's responsibility to dispose of

Dear Resident,

Effective January 1, 2024, the curbside brush & bulky service will change from monthly to quarterly collection. Please see the service calendar for the dates each quarter that we will collect this debris for that set-out. You now have up to four set-out opportunities per year to plan your tree and plant trimming, as well as bulky waste. Here are some refreshers below along with the limit amount changes:

- **We will collect up to 12 cubic yards of Brush each quarter, which is double the size you have now. (Approximately two car lengths) Any amount over this will be tagged and left behind until the next collection.**
- All Brush (tree trimmings, branches, palms) and bulky items must be placed at curbside in the front of your lot during the days indicated on the Brush calendar. **(No more alley collections for brush/bulky, or trash carts)**
- **Any debris placed before or after the dates on the calendar will be subject to a fine by the City and enforced.**
- Bulky items such as TVs over 32 inches, computers, tires, paint, construction material, and any hazardous household items will NOT be picked up and are the responsibility of the resident to safely discard.
- If you miss the time of the pick-up and place the brush and bulky out the same day we will not be able to come back once we make a pass. (Refer back to Brush Calendar)
- All yard waste must be on your property near the curb in front of your home and away from power lines, telephone poles, meters, vehicles, and fences. (if you have an exception call the city)
- If you have a vehicle whether it is yours or a visitor's near the Brush/Bulky pile at the time of pick-up we will not collect it.
- Vacant lots next to or near your home are not to be dumping grounds for this yard waste and is prohibited. Any violation of this will be subject to fines and enforced by the City.
- **Trash bags cannot be mixed in with brush piles and must be placed in trash Cart.**
- **If limbs, twigs, and bulky are small enough to place in your waste cart please do so.**
- If you have brush or bulky items that you need to discard in between our collection you can take them to the City's Collection Center for a fee. (Must present your utility bill to show proof of residence)
