Date	Activity
<b>April-May</b>	Mailing of notices of appraised value by chief appraiser.
<b>April 30*</b>	The chief appraiser prepares and certifies to the tax assessor for each county, municipality, and school district participating in the appraisal district an estimate of the taxable value.
<b>May 15</b>	Deadline for submitting appraisal records to ARB.
<b>July 20 (Aug. 30)</b>	Deadline for ARB to approve appraisal records.
<b>July 25</b>	Deadline for chief appraiser to certify rolls to taxing units or provide estimated values.
<b>August XX, 2024</b>	Deadline to call for an election.
<b>August XX, 2024</b>	Deadline to adopt a tax rate above the voter-approval tax rate.
<b>Done</b>	Certification of anticipated collection rate by collector.
<b>August 1, 2024</b>	Calculation of no-new-revenue and voter-approval tax rates.
<b>August 1, 2024</b>	Publication of no new revenue and voter-approval tax rates on tax office and appraisal district websites; submission to governing body.
<b>August 2, 2024</b>	72-hour notice for meeting ( <i>Open Meetings Notice</i> ).
<b>August 6, 2024</b>	Meeting of governing body to discuss tax rate; take record vote and schedule public hearing or meeting (as required). <b>August 10<sup>th</sup> Workshop – 1st Draft</b> <b>August 24<sup>th</sup> Workshop – 2<sup>nd</sup> draft</b> <b>September 3<sup>rd</sup> – Council adopt budget and set tax rate.</b> <b>September 10<sup>th</sup> – Approve Tax Rate</b>
	Notice of Public Hearing or Notice of Public Meeting is the first quarter-page notice in newspaper and on TV and website, if available, published at least seven days before public hearing/meeting.
<b>September 5, 2024</b>	72-hour notice for public hearing ( <i>Open Meetings Notice</i> )
<b>September 10, 2024</b>	Public hearing.
<b>September 5, 2024</b>	72-hour notice for meeting at which governing body will adopt tax rate if rate was not adopted at previous Public Hearing/Meeting ( <i>Open Meetings Notice</i> )
<b>September 10, 2024</b>	Meeting to adopt tax rate, if rate was not adopted at previous Public Hearing/Meeting . Meeting is within 7 days of first Public Hearing/Meeting. Taxing unit must adopt tax rate by Sept. 29 or 60 days after receiving certified appraisal roll, whichever is later.

\*Tax Code Section 81.06 directs that if a date falls on a weekend, the deadline is extended to the following regular business day
